## OCTOBER 5TH 2020 MUNICIPAL MEETING FOLLOW-UP

❖ Interim General Manager Me Christian Genest has been confirmed in the position of permanent Director General, congratulations to Me Genest.

❖ Assistant Director General Danielle Sauvé will offer more hours for a certain period of time in order to avoid service delays.

❖ Renovations to the municipal garage are going well and should be completed by early November.

❖ A proposal for the extension of the post office was adopted by the council.

❖ A request from a citizen for a minor exemption has been accepted following the recommendation of the "Comité de Consultation en Urbanisme". We wish to thank the two citizens who took part in the process who demonstrated great professionalism.

❖ The council supported a request of the Coué development owners to forward to "La commission de la toponymie" a name proposal for the road access to the land to be developed.

❖ The Sureté du Québec in collaboration with the MRC has requested that each municipality adopt a resolution in order to confirm the mandate with regards to dog complaints. The Dundee municipality had already confirmed the mandate.

## A BIT OF OUR HISTORY

### **St-Agnès de Dundee catholic cemetery.**

*The next time you pass by the Catholic cemetery at the corner of Ridge and Smallman take a good look at the alignment of the tombstones. In the old section of the cemetery (the first 12 rows) the tombstones are facing north while in the more recent section they are facing east! Our research indicates that the first church (chapel) was built in 1862 where the cemetery cross is located and was in the north-south axis. The main entrance of the church was facing south of the old section of the cemetery. Fire destroyed the church. A second church was built across Smallman in front of the cemetery and this is why the tombstones are facing east in the newer section. Our internet site will be ready early 2021. Citizens who show an interest in Dundee's history will be able to consult the site.*
